- Corporate Governance (Legal, Insurance, HR, Operations)
- Financial Control (Accounting, Banking, Finance, Negotiation, Procurement)
- Diversity & Inclusion (Community, Networking, Connections)

Specific skills needed on the Board include

- All Board Members must have leadership experience in business and/or other areas
- At least one legal advisor
- Financial representation including at least one accounting professional and one investment professional
- Local business leaders
- Marketing
- Bike industry relationships

Our goal is to include the following on the board.

- Representation from all CAMBA communities including but not limited to Hayward to Cable, Ashwabay, and the outreach communities of the Twin Cities, Duluth, central & southern Wisconsin communities, and greater Minnesota

Candidates must possess the following criteria to be considered for the board.

- Must be a CAMBA Member
- Leadership experience in business and/or other areas
- Skills through expertise that can be leveraged to advance CAMBA initiatives
- Financial growth potential through ability to contribute and/or provide connections to supporters
- Capable of listening to CAMBA user's needs to develop CAMBA rather than bringing personal agendas
- Passion for furthering a local Chequamegon connection or presence, enthusiasm for CAMBA, and/or singletrack mountain biking
